Discussion Questions

- 1. The "Gospel in Motion" must be propelled along by a source of power. What sources of power propel you along in life? In your work? In your family? In your loving and serving? Are those sources within you or outside of you? Are they powerful & lasting?
- 2. Jesus knew His work of building the church and seeking and saving the lost would require His presence within us, and His Holy Spirit's "dunamis" power within us. When he said "wait" in Jerusalem for the "gift", what was the level of importance that they obey him right then? How important was and is the "gift" to the Apostles & every Disciple?
- 3. In vs. 4 Jesus prophesied they would be "baptized" shortly, in the Holy Spirit. Why is the indwelling residence of the Holy Spirit so important? Who received the gift? What is the significance of being baptized in the Spirit for a believer then and now?
- 4. Jesus made it clear that the demonstrated power of the Spirit was not for building an earthly kingdom. What was the power to be loosed for in vs. 8 and why?
- 5. In vs. 9-11 the two angels said Jesus would return again in His second coming. What implications does His "imminent" return have for you and your daily life? What urgency drives your part in the Gospel being on the move?
