Discussion Questions

- 1. Peter, newly baptized in the Spirit and filled with the Spirit...got up and moved from being generally out-of-control before Pentecost to under the Spirit's control, what does that say is possible for you? What fires are lit within you by the Spirit as you read? Why?
- 2. In vs. 14-15 Peter was suddenly changed and transformed. Identify how many ways he was changed from the start of Passover to preaching this amazing, convicting message?
- 3. The passages Peter quoted to the listening Jews had a powerful role in convicting them. Describe them in your own words and why they were so "on target" for his audience. A. Vs. 16-21 (Joel 2:28-30)
 - B. Vs. 25-28 (Psalm 16:8-11)
 - C. Vs. 34-36 (Psalm 110:1)
- 4. In vs. 37-40, in what ways did the Holy Spirit work in Peter to use him to bring about change and transformation in the Jewish crowd? List the 3 "C's" of the Spirit's work.
- 5. The Gospel is on the move for the first time without Jesus present. What is the role of the Spirit in advancing the Church and it's message through Peter and you and me, bringing about a response in such a significant way in vs. 41? Discuss.
