Discussion Questions

1.	How would you describe the church, the body of Christ being "the Gospel in Motion" in our present day? Is it any different than the early church? Share a few characteristics as you observe them.
2.	In vs. 1, Luke makes it clear that his Gospel account, the book of Luke was a record of what Jesus began, to do and to teach. Why was it a beginning? What does it imply about him continuing to do and to teach?
3.	At the turning point of Jesus ascending to heaven and sitting down at the right hand of the Father, what does the Book of Acts record that is a continuation of vs. 1 in the time of the early church? Why is it important that it is understood what Jesus is continuing to do then and now?
4.	What is Luke wanting us to see in the Book of Acts about the early church doing and teaching what he saw first-hand? Why is it important that what Luke recorded as an Apostle, be continued on by Disciples then and Disciples today?
