Discussion Questions

- 1. The Lawrence's, C&MA International Workers in France in their video said that hard soil is only broken up by "long, consistent, faithful presence in people's lives. Why is that? By what guidance do we decide when to put the Gospel into motion in someone's life?
- 2. In any relationship we're in, there must come a time when we boldly communicate the Good News of the Gospel. This is called our "Real Need", which is Jesus. After the healing of the lame man, How did Peter know just how to do that? How do we know?
- 3. God uniquely created you to minister to people in a specific place at specific times. When you know what to say, do, pray, discern...where does that come from? Who guides you and who receives the glory as you communicate to people?
- 4. It took the IW workers 2-years before the Spirit opened the door to communicate the Real Condition and the Real Need of their friend. How important was patiently and prayerfully waiting? To pointing each person to faith in Jesus?
- 5. In vs. 19, why is it so crucial that we boldly call every person, at some point in our relationship to deal with their sin, lovingly, but without apology? How important is repenting and turning to God? Discuss and pray together.
