<u>Discussion Questions</u>	
1.	Tell your group about a faith community you've been involved with that operated like a smooth functioning resurrection community? Share a number of the characteristics of that church body that were healthy and life-giving.
2.	Why does it seem so difficult today for the local church to be marked by oneness? Does Jesus prayer in John 17:20-24 give us any sense of why it was so important and difficult?
3.	Holding tightly to material possessions is exhausting. Why do we chase so hard after them and then struggle to give them away when the true owner prompts us to do so?
4.	The Apostles became powerful, anointed storytellers in testifying about the resurrection. What hinders you from becoming such a storyteller?
5.	In vs. 33b-34a, the smoothly operating, extravagantly generous body, without exception caused every needy person to no longer be needy. Why might such a healthy body be called the "gold standard" of body life? What action is the Spirit nudging you to take?
