Discussion Questions

1. Tell a life story about a time you vividly remember feeling like you were "Coming Alive" in your personal life? A time in your spiritual life? What made it so powerful and alive?
2. In vs. 12, the Gospel remained "in motion" and kept moving ahead, because of the supernatural "signs and wonders" God did through the Apostles. Why would such an experience cause people to believe in Christ and embrace the church "coming alive"?
3. In vs. 13-14, what caused people to be repelled by the early church and why? (4:1-11) In spite of what happened to Ananias and Sapphira, what caused people to still be irresistibly drawn to Christ and the early church and why?
4. What would cause people to be magnetically attracted to Jesus and the church? Were the healings, signs and wonders what many wanted? What caused others to believe and embrace this "coming alive" people and their faith community? Discuss.
5. Do you believe in Christ and his death, burial and resurrection by faith in His written Word, or do you struggle with unbelief, because you need to see signs, wonders and healings like many who walked away? What might cause you to seek to "come alive" in Christ?
