PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this role is to personally live a healthy, thriving life worthy of our Lord Jesus, while consistently engaging a multi-faceted life of personal worship. From such a life of worship, this position should then influence worship team members to follow your lead presenting a shared team dynamic to the guests and attendees of Parkside Church.

QUALITIES, SKILLS AND EDUCATION

1. Character - Genuine, authentic, transparent...becoming more and more like Christ!
2. Competency - Talent, refined by practice and skill development...to remove all distractions from the worship experience...reflected in your team members.
3. Capacity - An ability to go deep relationally, wide in multiplying leaders, high in personal worship and development...increasingly leading others into the same.
4. Chemistry - Can't be created, only recognized and celebrated.
5. Culture - Aligned, affirmed, fully embracing who Parkside presently is...and who we desire Parkside as a community of believers to become.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS

1. Engage
 - a. Lead Pastor - Engage, communicate and coordinate well in a timely fashion, follow his lead, strengthen his hand.
 - b. Staff - Engage and collaborate w/staff as needed within this part-time role.
 - c. Team - Engage present members, recruit and engage new members, folding them in while embracing their various levels of skill and ability.
2. Plan and Prepare
 - Utilizing Planning Center, coordinate with the lead pastor/relevant staff in overall service planning, team selection, music selection, preparation and organization.

- Learn and master click tracks as utilized during practice and worship experiences
- 3. Practice and Develop
 - Your own skills, talents and abilities.
 - Establish a healthy expectation of skillful worship that requires dedicated practice and advancement of learned skill levels. Auditions all team members.
- 4. Prayer & Spirit-led Leadership
 - Since prayer is our first work, lead in worship by bathing your personal worship; team worship and corporate worship in prayer, both alone and in community.
 - As John 4:24 says, seek to worship and lead in worship from your spirit, in tune with the Holy Spirit first as an example and then as a consistent pattern and experience before the congregation.

RELATIONSHIPS

1. Reports to and is reviewed by the Lead Pastor.
2. Coordinates and collaborates with the Tech Director.
3. Collaborates with and receives support from administrative and ministry staff.
